A new solar YoYo bench will be exhibited at the Michael Cacoyannis Foundation on June 20th, the place where it started its journey in 2010 through the \*etsi platform for the environment. After the exhibition it will be moved to Sissi's Art Room. The solar YoYo bench is a contemporary design based on renewable energy sources, reinforced with photovoltaic panels, thus emphasizing its environmentally friendly purpose.

YoYo bench is designed by Rodanthi Senduka, creator of the Emblem of Olympic Games Athens 2004, and Head Creative Director & Founder of Red Design Consultants. Throughout the years, it has won 5 international and Greek awards for its design.
